Warranty and Installation Instructions

Installation Instructions

1. Choose the desired position to mount the fan and ensure there are no hidden obstructions.
2. Use the template to mark the mounting hole.
3. Use a jigsaw, keyhole saw or other appropriate method to cut along marked line.
4. Remove grille, make electrical connections and insert fan assembly into hole.
5. Fix fan assembly to wall ensuring knurled thumb nut is at the bottom position.
6. Ensure flex is not fouling fan blades.
7. Replace grille and tighten knurled thumb nut.
8. Align external vent with fan housing and fix to outside wall.
9. The appliance must be fitted with a means of disconnection in the fixed wiring system in accordance with the AS/NZS3000 wiring rules.
10. Ensure that back-flow of gases into the room from an open flue of gas or other fuel-burning appliances is prevented.

Caution

To function correctly, fan must have free air. In some instances a return air grille may be required.

This appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons unless they have been adequately supervised by a responsible person to ensure that they can use the appliance safely, and to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

Electrical wiring must be carried out by a suitably qualified person.

Extra Protection

In addition to Australian Standards approval, this fan is fitted with an impedance protected motor. Restricting airflow and obstructing fan blades can cause premature failure.

Template

Centre Hole

Use this template to mark the mounting hole for the fan.

Use a nail or similar object to anchor the template at the centre hole, then insert a pencil through the template at the point indicated (adjacent to the correct fan size) and scribe the circle.

Clean When Dirty or Clogged

Dirty fan blades and clogged grilles can drastically reduce the fan's working life and void warranties.

Cleaning Instructions

Ensure that the fan is switched off from the supply mains before removing the guard.

Grille and Louvres: Remove and wash in warm soapy water then rinse. Cloudy ammonia is recommended with a bottle brush for stubborn grease.

Fan Blade: Wipe blade with a rag, moistened with the above solution.

NEVER immerse the motor in cleaning solution or any other liquid.

All defective parts will be replaced free of charge. 1. This warranty is only valid for appliances installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.
2. This appliance must not be modified or changed in any way.
3. All wiring must be carried out by a licensed electrician or similarly qualified person and must be connected to the voltage requirements as specified on the ratings label.
4. The manufacturer does not accept liability for any direct or consequential damage, loss or other expense arising from misuse or incorrect installation and operation of the appliance.
